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**N**estled away in the Blue Ridge Mountains in Lake Toxaway, North Carolina, is the seven-acre retreat called The Cabins at Seven Foxes. Its rustic, earthy charm coupled with modern-day amenities makes this haven a perfect getaway that is not too far from home.

The five secluded cabins, situated around Fox Creek, have unique animal themes and charming decor, providing both comfort and luxury deep in the mountains. Deer Lodge, which sits atop the hill and offers a spectacular view, is a 1,200-square-foot house equipped with a king-size bed in the loft and twin beds downstairs. The Raccoon Loft is a two-bedroom A-frame with a panoramic view of both the mountains and barnyard meadow, which is complete with goats and miniature horses. The Bear Cave and Squirrel Nest both feature two double bedrooms, and the Fox Hole is a one-bedroom queen split level with a mountain view. Each of the cabins feature hardwood floors, quaint antiques, gas fireplaces, air-conditioning, fully-equipped kitchens and outdoor grills.

Canoeing, kayaking, fishing, horseback riding, and waterfall tours are just a few of the outdoor activities that await you at nearby sites. And for dining and cocktails, visit The Brown Trout Mountain Grille, which also features live entertainment. So, kick back and relax in the tranquil setting of Seven Foxes. ♦
